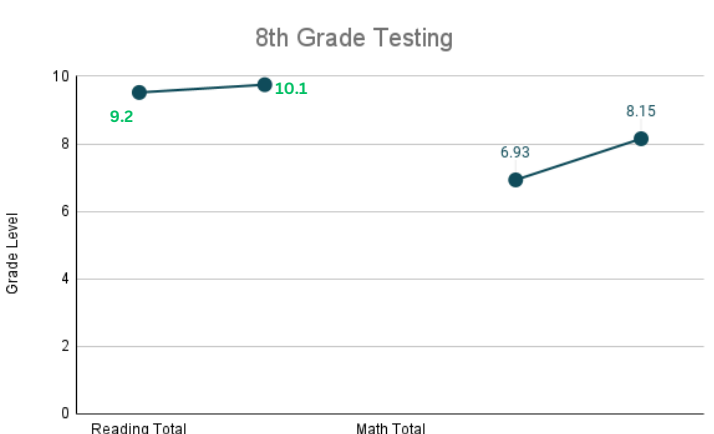
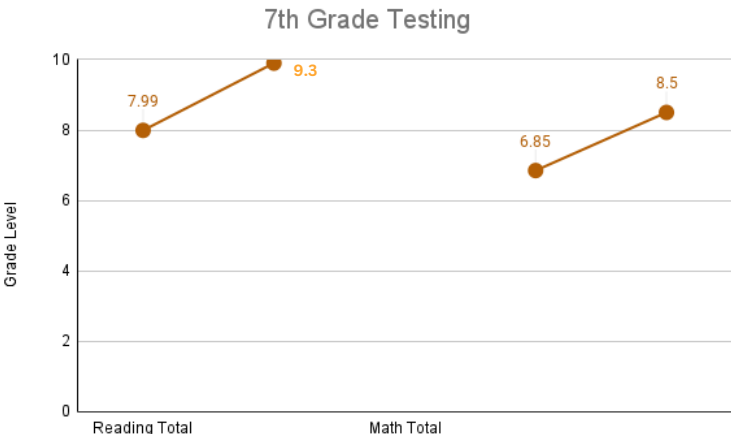

Iowa State Testing: Comparison from 2023 to 2024

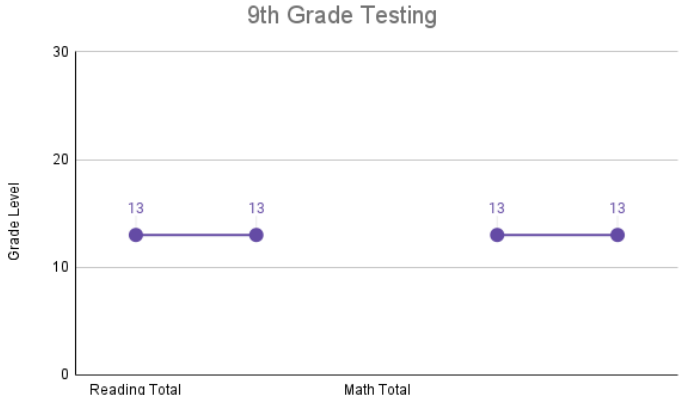
Lower Grammar Students exceeded the expectations for their Grade Levels
