A Day in the life of an IDA Student

What does a day at IDA look like?

Each day at IDA begins with fellowship and play in our commons area and at our playground. You might find students swinging on the swings, building forts, playing a soccer game on our soccer field,

or practicing for rugby club. After this early morning recess, students are shepherded into our commons area for our Chapel services. Chapel always starts out with pledges to our American Flag,

our Christian Flag, and our Holy Bible. We then move the students on to song, utilizing a mix of contemporary Christian music, hymnals, and classical prayers. A 15-20 minute “sermonette” is then done by one of our local church leaders.

After Chapel, students move into our academic day. Visitors will find our students fully engaged in our Classical and Christian curriculum. From the earliest years in school, students learn the Old and New Testaments, theological and apologetics concepts, Latin, English, Grammar, American, Greek, and Roman History, Science, Math, and Classical Literature, among other subjects.

Choir is so much more than just learning a couple of songs to sing for an audience. This year we have worked with three levels of choirs: elementary, middle school, and high school classes. In addition to singing, the 1st-4th graders studied some music theory, learning names of notes and rests and their value. They worked to read music notes and that allowed them to learn to play bells for a final concert.

Our 5th-12th grade choirs also worked on learning basic notation in music, and how to effectively use that in their singing. Singing two and three part harmony was a great learning step for most. A combined choir was used to practice what they were learning for our last concert on Maundy Thursday.

Playing recorders was introduced this spring. It has been an effective way to learn reading music, learning note values, playing together, and just having fun making music together. We look forward to finishing the year learning more about creating music as we enjoy the recorders.

- Imago Dei joined the Wisconsin Student Music Association (WSMA) this year. This allows middle and high school students to participate in Solo and Ensemble contests throughout the year. This includes vocal, band, strings, and piano students. We hope to select students to be in honors choirs, and honors orchestra next year. We want the love of music to flourish at Imago Dei in future years.


