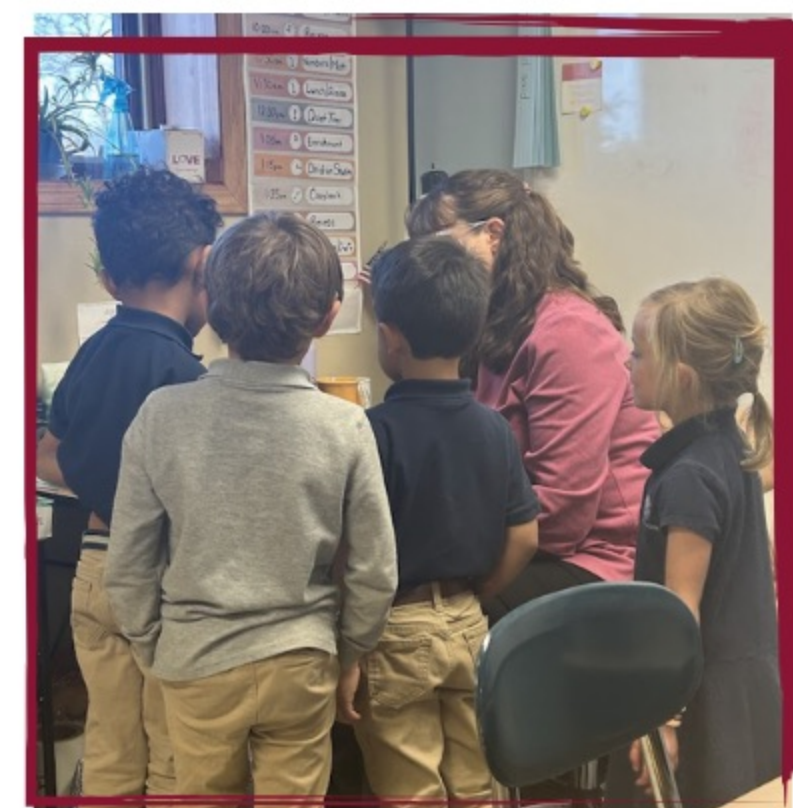

"I like to play with my friends. I like lunchtime and recess and playing outside. I enjoy chapel and getting to dance while we sing!"

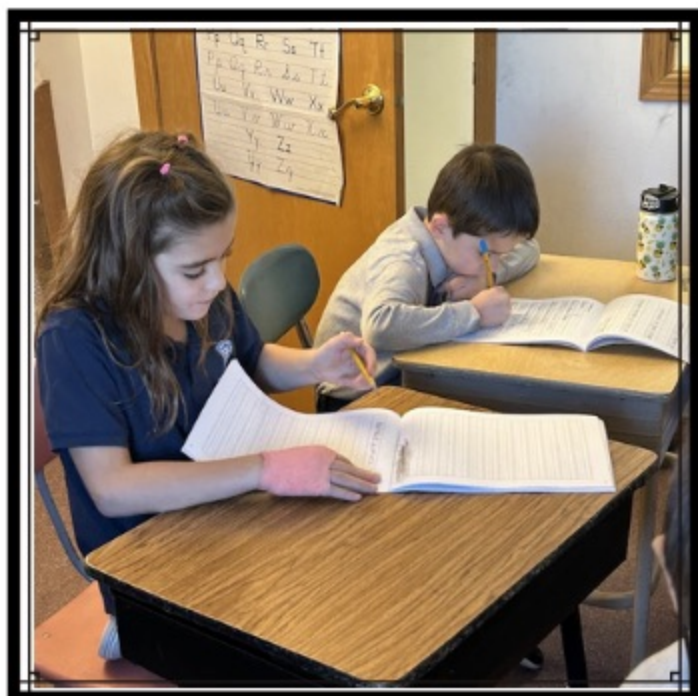
